On June 19, 2021, Daniel Jackson, an American attorney, passed away. In his memory, his wife, Linda Mrowicki, made a generous donation for Covid-19 relief in Sri Lanka. Linda came to Sri Lanka in 2014 to teach in our Intensive Buddhist English Course in Kandy and taught in the Intensive Buddhist English Course in Kolkata, India, in 2018. There will be a blessing ceremony for Daniel on September 26 at the Blue Lotus Temple in Woodstock, Illinois, at about 9 A. M.

Our appeal elicited more donations. With these funds, we were able to provide a bag of groceries and a cash grant of about US\$50 to eighteen families which had been seriously affected by the virus. Our staff and a local shopkeeper arranged the donations to two of the families. The other families were identified by our friend, Sylvia, and her husband, Indrajith, who is a policeman in Kandy. They also delivered the donations.

All of the families were grateful and expressed their deep appreciation to the donors. One woman explained in tears that her electricity had been cut. With the money she received, she was able to restore the electricity, and she was overjoyed that, with the groceries, she was able to provide decent meals for her children.
