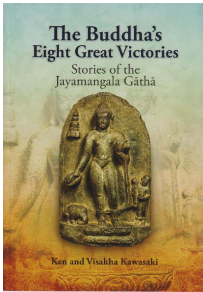


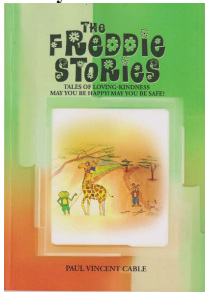

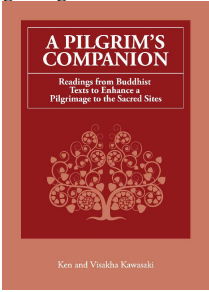
The Freddie Stories:

a Pilgrimage to the Sacred Sites

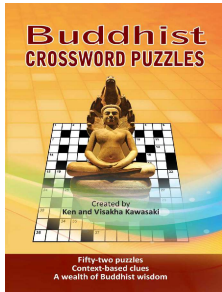

This is not a guide-book. Rather than describing the places visited on a pilgrimage, it adds meaning to each site and places it within the context of the Buddha’s life and teaching.

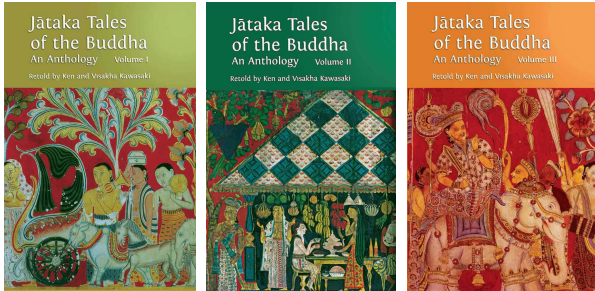
