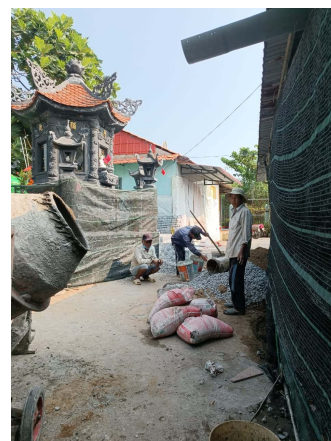
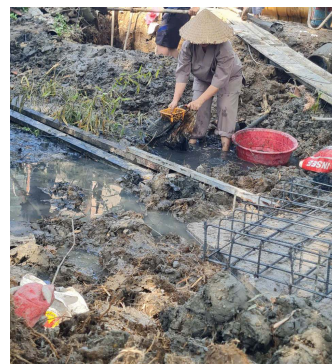


Assisting in the Construction of a Nunnery in Vietnam
