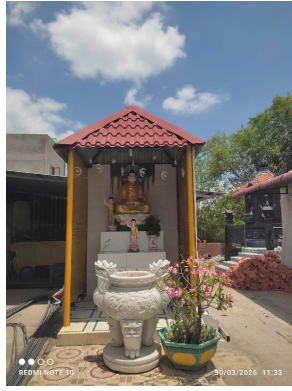


# Two Projects of Buddhist Relief Mission

This vitally important institution, operated by the Sri Lanka Cancer Society, Kandy Branch, provides free full board and lodging to out-of town patients receiving extended treatment at Kandy National Hospital. The home depends entirely of private donations. Our meal consists of soup, egg-salad sandwiches, vegetable cutlets, yoghurt, bananas, tea, and juice. Each month, we also donate dry rations and essential medicine. All donors are listed on the form shown above and receive a blessing from the patients before they partake of the meal.
